

Definition of Partnership Levels

Accommodations include:

Medication management: Medications are filled and delivered by Seifert Drug in Elkhart, IN. Care Partners will assist with reminders and cues to take medications as prescribed by the physician.

All housekeeping and laundry needs, dusting, sweeping, moping, bathroom and kitchenette. Bedding changes once a week or as needed.

Activities: Daily exercise, meaningful activities and outings.

Partnership with scheduling appointments and transportation as needed.

Basic self-care: verbal reminders only, no physical assistance with self-care tasks. Supervision for fall prevention.

Sophisticated Support: requires partnership assistance with any of the following basic self-care tasks:

- Grooming/hygiene: More than 25% physical or cognitive partnership this may include brushing teeth or hair, shaving, washing face or hands or applying makeup.
- Bathing: More than 25% mobility partnership for transferring into/out of shower
- Partnership with mobility needs to/from meals or common areas.
- Bathing: More than 25% physical or cognitive partnership with upper body and/or lower body bathing.
- More than 25% physical or cognitive partnership with peri-care mobility and clothing management with toileting

Refined Care: requires partnership assistance with any of the following basic self-care tasks:

- Grooming/hygiene: More than 50% physical or cognitive partnership this may include brushing teeth or hair, shaving, washing face or hands or applying makeup.
- Dressing: More than 50% physical or cognitive partnership with upper body and/or lower body dressing.
- Partnership with mobility needs to/from meals or common areas.
- Bathing: More than 50% physical or cognitive partnership with upper body and/or lower body bathing.
- More than 50% physical or cognitive partnership with peri-care, mobility and clothing management with toileting

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Ultimate Guidance: requires partnership assistance with any of the following basic self-care tasks:

- Grooming/hygiene: Greater than 75% physical or cognitive partnership this may include brushing teeth or hair, shaving, washing face or hands or applying makeup.
- Dressing: Greater than 75% physical or cognitive partnership with upper body and/or lower body dressing.
- Partnership with mobility needs to/from meals or common areas.
- Bathing: Greater than 75% physical or cognitive partnership with upper body and/or lower body bathing.
- Greater than 75% physical or cognitive partnership with mobility and clothing management with toileting
- Any level of assistance with self-feeding
- Use of mechanical lifts

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
